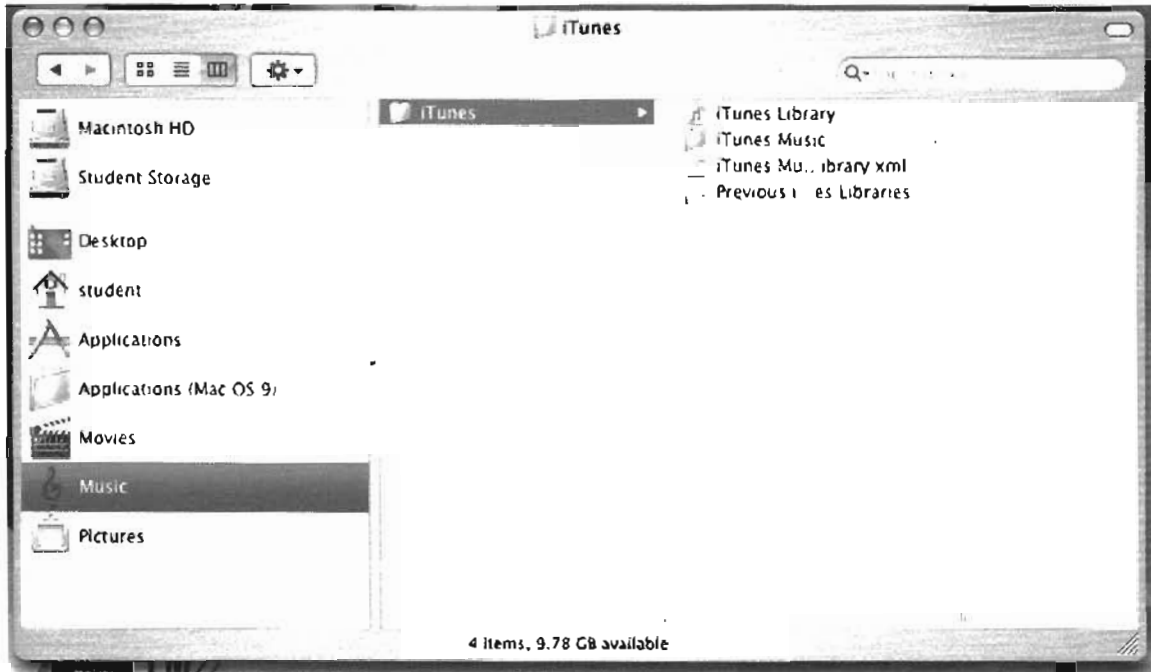


MOVING YOUR ITUNES MUSIC LIBRARY

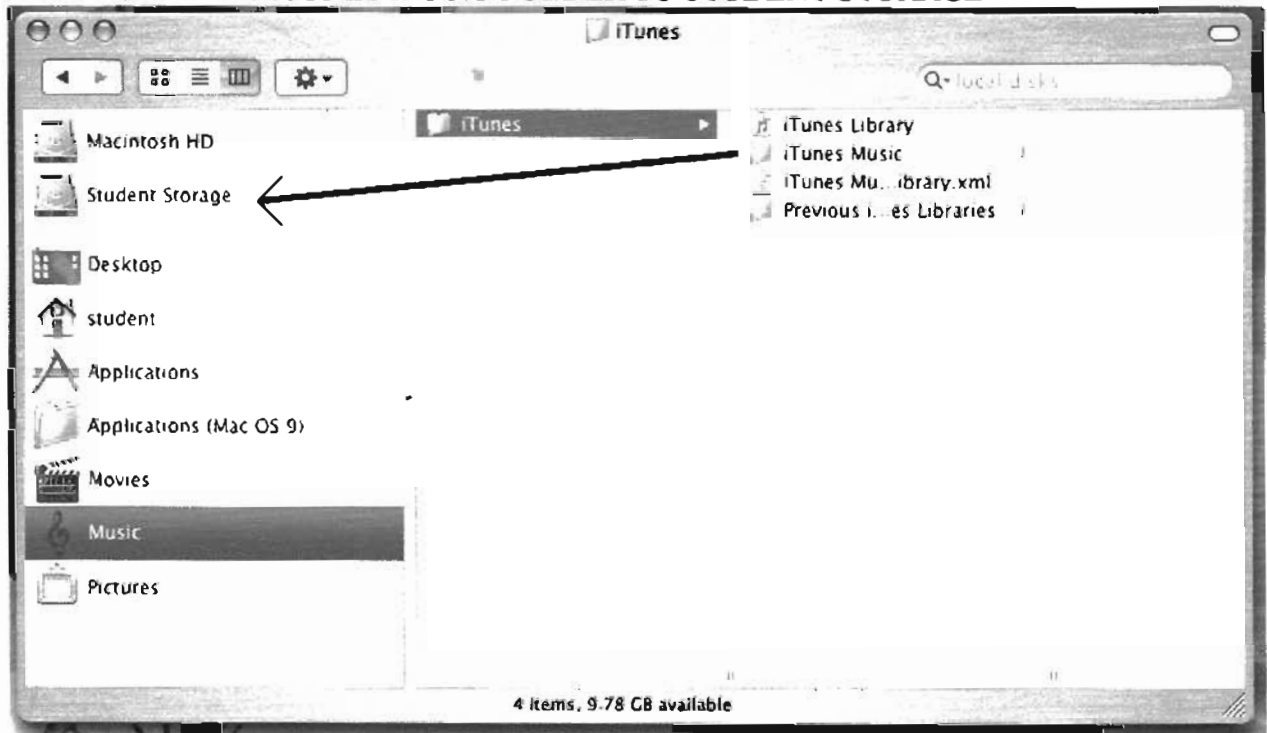
If you are getting a "Startup disk is full" message at startup you may need to move your iTunes library to Student Storage to free up room on Macintosh HD.

FIRST, FIND YOUR ITUNES MUSIC.....

Macintosh HD → Music → iTunes → iTunes Music



THEN DRAG THE ITUNES MUSIC FOLDER TO STUDENT STORAGE



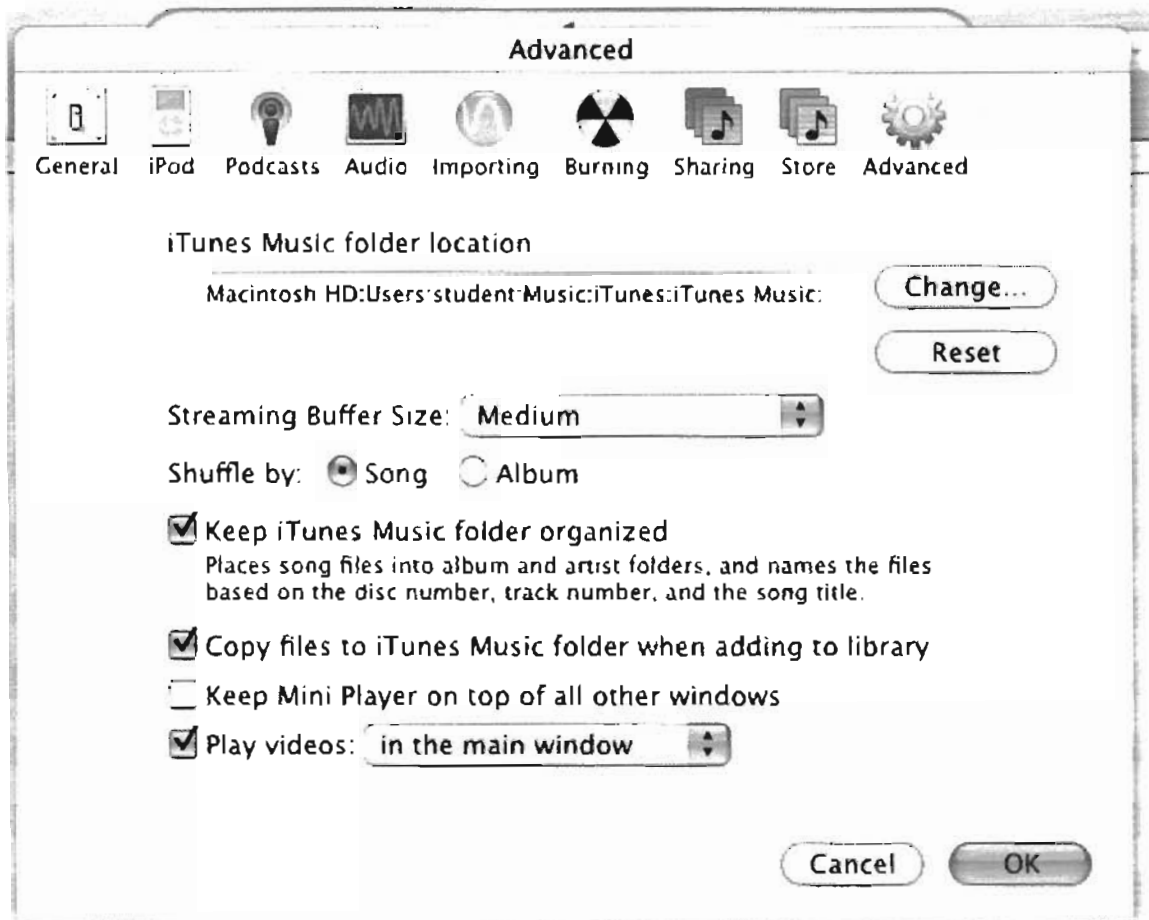
DELETE THE ORIGINAL ITUNES MUSIC FOLDER FROM MACINTOSH HD.

Macintosh HD → Music → iTunes → iTunes Music
Drag iTunes Music folder to the trash and empty the trash.

TELL ITUNES WHERE THE MUSIC FOLDER IS NOW LOCATED.

Open iTunes and from iTunes menu (next to the blue apple) go to Preferences.

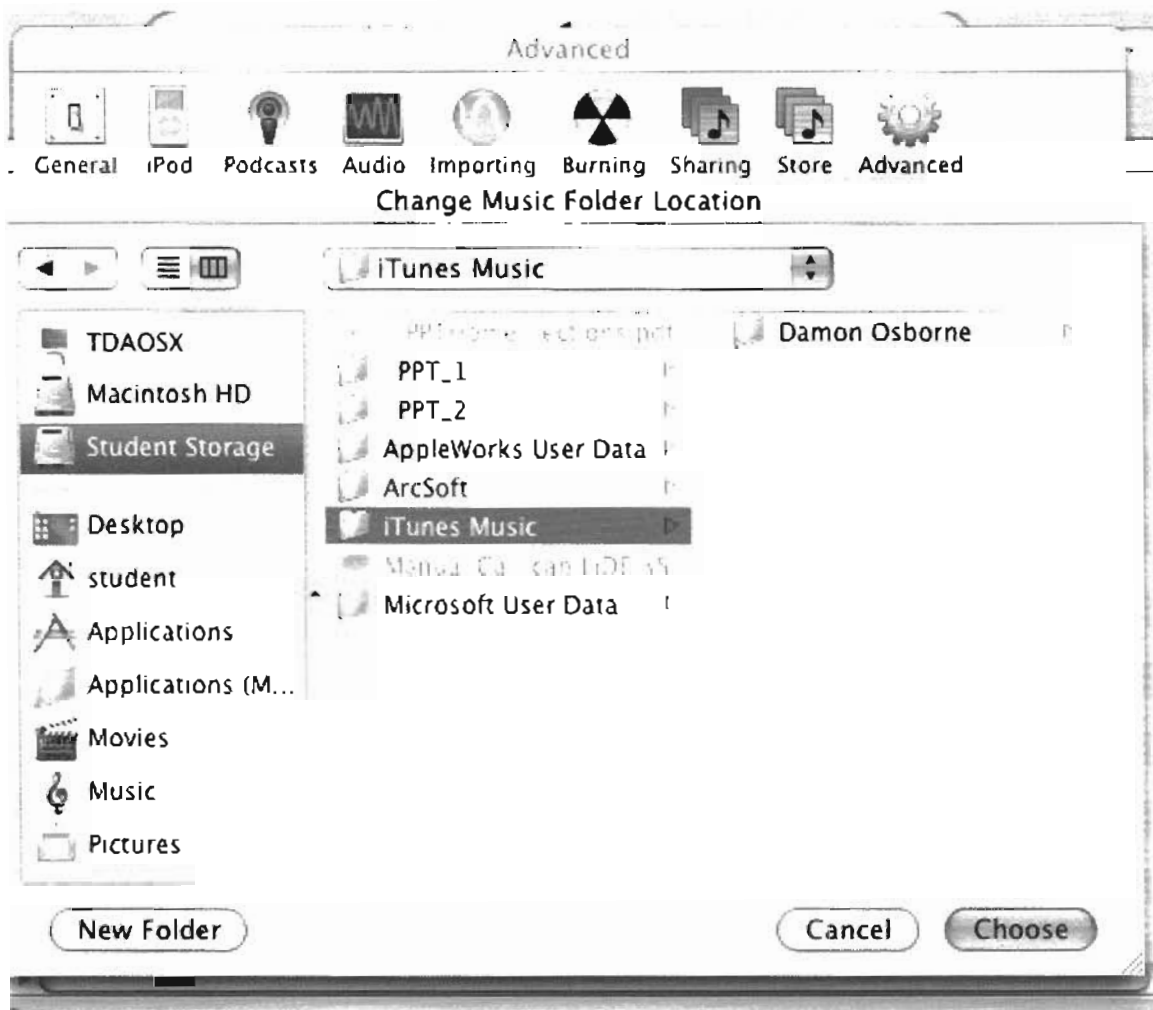
iTunes → Preferences → Advanced



Under the iTunes Music folder location you will see the old location on Macintosh HD.

CLICK ON "CHANGE" AND A NEW WINDOW WILL OPEN.....

Click on Student storage and then the iTunes Music folder. Then click on the blue Choose button..



YOU HAVE NOW POINTED ITUNES TO THE NEW LOCATION OF YOUR ITUNES FOLDER.

MAKE SURE YOU HAVE DELETED THE ORIGINAL FOLDER FROM MACINTOSH HD.
